July 31 is the deadline for the William Threlkeld Scholarship applications!

However, applications are accepted only through July 31, 2011.

How the 1862 Adams cuff led to today's handcuffs

Handcuffs are nothing new, having been around for several hundred years. However, early cuffs were simply metal rings that locked in place — often painful for people with thick wrists and ineffective for those with thin wrists.

In 1862, everything changed. W.V. Adams invented adjustable ratchets to bind wrists securely, regardless of their size. With a square bow with notches outside that engaged with a teardrop-shaped lock mechanism, the "one size fits all" handcuff was gone forever.

In 1865, John Tower used the Adams patent as the basis for his mass-produced handcuffs. The Tower Company manufactured the world's most commonly used handcuffs until World War II – all based off of W.V. Adams' original idea.
